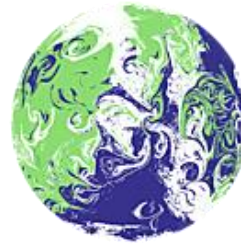


COP26 – United Nations Climate Change Conference takes place between 1st – 12th November 2021
